6. Booth set up times are 7:00 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Sunday October 9th, 2011. Gates (vehicle access) will close at 10:00 a.m. to vendors.
7. Booths must be free standing with no pegs or guy wires.
8. No vehicles are allowed to remain in booth area. Space is provided nearby (within 150 ft)
9. Tear down may begin at 6:00 p.m. Sunday October 9th, 2011. Everything must be removed no later than 12 midnight.
10. No electricity is available.

This Contract and Indemnification is made between the Floresville Peanut Festival Association, a Texas non-profit association (referred to as "We" or "The Association"), and

You, as Vendor, agree to abide by all rules and regulations promulgated by the Floresville Peanut Festival Association which are provided to you at or before the time of your initial booth setup as identified above.

We, The Floresville Peanut Festival Association, are not responsible for the safety, health, or welfare of your owners, employees, family members, or other participants, nor are we responsible for the safety of your vehicles, booths, equipment, supplies, or property. Further, You agree to indemnify and hold The Association harmless from any and all claims, damages, or assertions of liability by any person or persons whatsoever arising out of or in any way related to any of your activities at the Floresville Peanut Festival.

In the event that you have breached any of the terms of this agreement during the festival, The Association shall have the right (but not the obligation) to cancel this lease, and to have you remove the booth, and all of your equipment and supplies immediately.

This agreement constitutes the final understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof. This agreement shall be solely enforceable in the District Court of Wilson County, Texas. The terms of this agreement may not be contradicted or modified by any evidence of any prior or contemporaneous oral or written agreements, and the terms hereof may not be modified by any agreement except by a written agreement signed by both parties and dated after the date hereof.

11:00am- Gates open to public
6:00pm- Grounds close vendor teardown may start
10:00pm- All vendors must close
12:00am- All items must be removed from grounds
